In sunlight, the petaloids color pales while large carpels become entirely purple. Mid-late bloom. Ball form, no stamens, no pollen. A prolific seeder. Big flower and side buds, very strong grower, broad robust bush. 34-40 in height. Foliage deep green with maturity. Award winning progeny No. 990 HM - 1995, No. 995 AM - 1991. 1095 HM - 1992.
